IN-PERSON VISITATION SCHEDULE FOR ADULTS AND ADOLESCENTS

In-person visitation is limited to 45 minutes. Zoom visitation is available 7 days a week by request, and as availability permits.

ENTRY PROCESS

1. Present your valid ID, along with the patient's name, and security code.
 - a. Visitors must be 18 years or older.
 - b. If a patient is denying visitation, the staff will inform you upon check-in.
2. Complete a metal detector screening to ensure no prohibited items enter the hospital.
3. Complete a health screening to ensure you're not experiencing respiratory symptoms or recent exposure. Anyone who is feeling ill will not be granted entry for visitation.
4. Once cleared, please wait to be escorted to the designated visitation area.

CONTRABAND SCREENING

- Personal belongings and cell phones are **not** allowed in the visitation area. Please leave as many of your personal belongings in your car.
 - Limited lockers are available in the lobby if needed.
- All visitors must complete a metal detector screening to ensure no prohibited items enter the hospital. Visitors who refuse the contraband check will not be granted entry for visitation.
 - If you have any metal on you or in the body, please notify the staff.

HEALTH SCREENING

- Visitors will be screened for respiratory symptoms and exposure before entry is granted. Anyone with respiratory symptoms and feeling ill will not be granted entry for visitation.
- All visitors are required to wear a surgical face mask when present inside the facility.

THINGS TO KNOW

- Visitation will occur in the Gym. No on-unit visitation is allowed.
- Please do not bring any food or drinks.
- Patient belongings must be dropped off outside of check-in and visitation times. Patient belongings can be dropped off with reception at any time.
- We are a locked facility. Please be mindful of your surroundings and ask the staff if you need to leave or have any concerns.

To help keep everyone safe and comfortable, we kindly ask all visitors to follow our guidelines and procedures.

If these guidelines are not followed, we may need to pause visitation.
